

TERMS & CONDITIONS
I-SEM Market Readiness Assessment

1. These terms relate to the collection and use of data from market participants in the context of the Market Readiness Assessment Programme for the I-SEM Project (the "Programme").
2. In these terms "us" or "we" refers to EirGrid plc, SONI Limited and each of their respective subsidiaries, affiliates and their respective parent(s) and/or subsidiary companies (the "EirGrid Group").
3. During the Programme you agree to provide to us certain data, including comments and data about you (the "Data") at regular intervals. The Data may be collected by various means including over telephone, via email and through an on-line survey by a third party survey provider.
4. The Data will be treated as strictly confidential and shared by us, and with our agents and delegates (including third party survey provider), and regulatory authorities in Ireland and Northern Ireland only for the purposes set out below:
 - (i) to prepare reports outlining the progress being made on the Programme;
 - (ii) to generate reports which will be presented at the Project Managers' Meetings (PMG) for the I-SEM Project and will be available to market participants and regulatory authorities in Ireland and Northern Ireland. The reports will also be published on the I-SEM Project webpage. The Data will be aggregated and anonymised within the reports. However, you acknowledge that it may be possible to make inferences about individual participants based on the content of the reports.
 - (iii) to identify and register issues and risks which are managed in I-SEM management systems;
 - (iv) to provide feedback or clarification to market participant (s) and address any specific issue(s).
5. If required in order to comply with law (including applicable freedom of information laws) or by any regulatory body and associated bodies (including the SEM Committee, the Commission for Energy Regulation and the Utility Regulator) the Data will be disclosed by us as necessary to meet our legal obligation to do so.
6. In processing the Data, we will comply with applicable data protection laws. To protect the Data we will use security measures that comply with Irish and Northern Irish law and meet international standards, including computer safeguards and secure files and buildings. However, you acknowledge that due to the nature of communication via the internet and other electronic communication media we are restricted from offering any guarantee to the privacy or confidentiality of information passing in this context. You acknowledge and accept that Data passed to us via electronic communication may not be free from interference by unauthorised persons, may not remain confidential and that it is submitted at your own risk.
